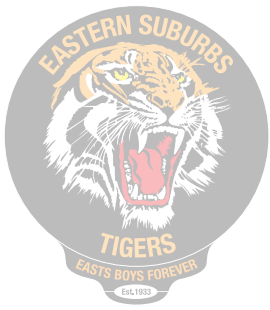

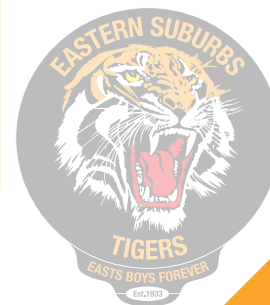

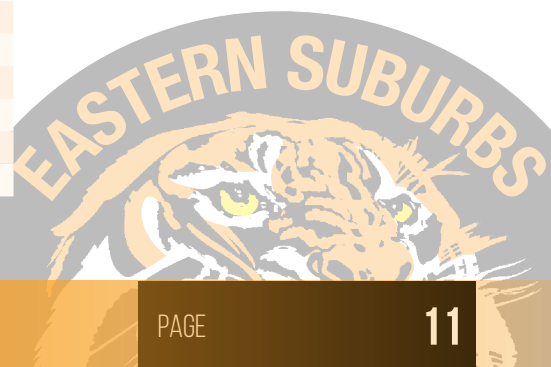

PRESIDENT & EXECUTIVE OFFICER

Dear members,

INTRUST SUPER CUP

The 2016 season was one of change for the Tigers with the resignation of former coach Craig Ingebrigtsen taking up a position with the Melbourne Storm's National Youth Competition side based on the Sunshine Coast.

Craig's move to the Sunshine Coast would provide an opportunity for 2015 assistant coach and Club Centurion, Scott Sipple, to step-up and take the reins as the Club's Head Coach. Scott has had much success as a coach, leading our BRL A grade side to three consecutive premierships in 2012, 2013 and 2014.

The season started well for the Tigers, and the side was extremely competitive for the first half the season, sitting in the top four on the ladder. However, a number of long-term injuries to key players tested our depth. The combination of losing in form half-back Billy Walters, experienced centre Shane Neumann, as well as forwards Jake Foster, Mat Pitman, John Puna, Ash Little proved costly. In addition, the side lost Melbourne Storm affiliate players, Dean Britt, Jeremy Hawkins and Francis Tualau for the majority of the season to injury.

However, injuries provided an opportunity for our younger players, including newcomers Shane Gillham, Adam Crear, Brodie Croft and Chris Ostwald to make the step-up and play first grade.

The side limped into the semi-finals after finishing in sixth place at the end of the regular season, before we travelled north to Townsville to face the third placed Townsville Blackhawks. Behind 14-4 at half-time we were still in the game, but unfortunately a poor second half saw the Blackhawks run away with the match in the second half, ending our season.

Whilst 2016 was a season that could have been, it provided an opportunity to blood a number of young players, who will be much better for the experience in 2017. Likewise, Coach Sipple, now with a year of first grade under his belt, will no doubt be a better coach for the experience.

We have recruited well for 2017, with the signing of three 2016 Queensland Residents representative players in Linc Port, David Murphy and Jack Svendsen, who will make Langland's Park their home in 2017. They will be joined by former Tigers skipper Steven Thorpe, who returns home after a successful two-year stint with Sheffield Eagles in the UK. Other signings also include halves Brayden Torpy and Gerard McCallum, outside backs Jarrod McNally, Conor Carey and Jack Creith as well as the return of winger-fullback Maele Seve.

BRISBANE RUGBY LEAGUE A GRADE

The BRL A grade side was severely affected by the abnormal injury toll in ISC, as well as season ending injuries to a number of our regular BRL players. However, this provided an opportunity for our FOGS Colts players to step-up and gain valuable experience playing against men.

The side placed sixth at the end of the regular fixtures and were eliminated when beaten by grand-finalist, the Ipswich Jets, in the first week of the play-offs.

Whilst finishing sixth, Coach Jason Di Lizio must be congratulated on his effort to field a competitive side each week, based on a limited playing roster at his disposal. Unfortunately, due to business and family commitments, Jason has stood down as coach for the 2017 season. We wish Jason all the best and thank him for his outstanding services over the past seasons. 2017 will see the return of former premiership winning Colts coach David Krause to Langland's Park as our new BRL A Grade coach.

FOGS COLTS

Our 2016 Colts side were the surprise packet for the Club progressing to the FOGS Colts Challenge grand final.

After losing near a full side in 2016 to the NRL's National Youth Competition, the Club did not have high expectations of the young squad. However, the squad, of which the majority hail from our junior affiliate clubs, played well above expectations and finished third at the end of the regular season.

The side beat the Norths Devils and Redcliffe Dolphins, both in golden-point to progress to the Grand Final, but unfortunately they were beaten by a talented Wynnum Manly Seagulls side 34-12 at Suncorp Stadium.

Congratulations to the coaching staff of Ian Gough, Gavin Payne and Steve Peoples for their outstanding work in 2016.

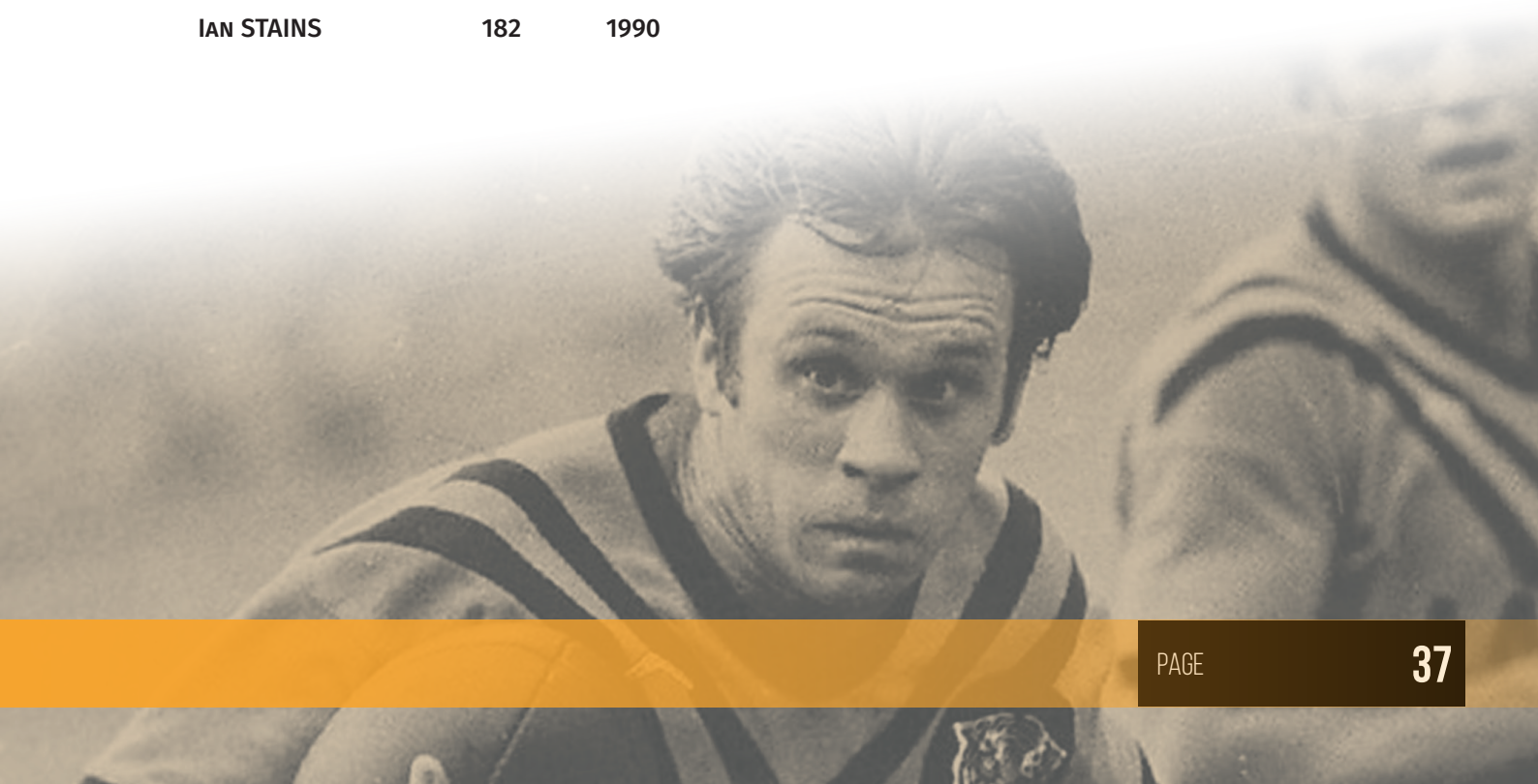

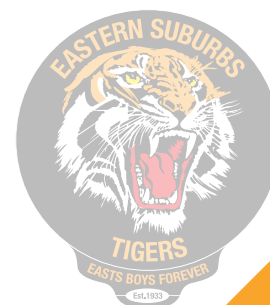
