

PRESIDENT & EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S

Dear members,

INTRUST SUPER CUP

The 2019 season was one of disappointment for the Tigers after failing to build on the 2018 ISC grand final.

The Club lost a number of players from the 2018 grand final side, including experienced campaigners Tommy Butterfield and David Tyrrell, but recruited a number of established first grade players, including Souths-Logan prop-forward Sam Lavea, Mackay Cutters back-rower Bennett Leslie, and experienced half-back Rhys Jacks.

The Club also recruited a number of young players in Curtis Dansey-Smaller from the Tweed Heads Seagulls, Aaron Booth from the Mackay Cutters, as well as Newcastle Knights players - Tom Hughes, Tyrone Amey and Matt Cooper.

The team started the season well, winning 7 of our first 8 games, and were sitting in 2nd place on the Intrust Super Cup ladder. However, fortunes changed with the team only winning 3 from the remaining 15 fixture games, and at the end of the regular season we were in 8th place on the ladder.

A change in the finals format saw us sneak into the play-offs under the new Top 8 format. We defeated Norths Devils 24-20 in week 1 of the finals series, but we were unfortunately beaten 24-22 by the Sunshine Coast Falcons in week 2.

In regards to milestones, long-serving centre Shane Neumann celebrated his 200th Queensland Cup game, whilst Jack Svendsen notched up his 50th first grade game for the Tigers.

Congratulations to Sam Lavea on winning the 2019 Patron's Trophy for Best and Fairest Player, and likewise to Chris Ostwald on winning the prestigious Loth Medal.

Congratulations to Brett Greinke on his selection in the Queensland Residents team, who defeated the NSW Blues at Redcliffe.

2019 also saw the retirement of experienced trio in Captain Jake Foster, Centurion Shane Neumann and winger Jarrod McInally. We wish them the very best in the future.

Finally, a big thank-you to Head Coach Scott Sipple, his support staff and the 2019 playing group for their tremendous efforts throughout the season.

Scott will move on after four seasons as the Club's Head Coach. Scott has been a tremendous servant for the Club and we wish him all the very best for the future.

Craig Hodges has been appointed Head Coach for the 2020 and 2021 seasons.

RUGBY LEAGUE BRISBANE (RLB) A GRADE

The RLB A grade side had a mixed season, finishing in 3rd spot on the In-Safe-Hands ladder, after winning 9 from 20 games in the regular season. Unfortunately, the team was eliminated in the first week of the finals series, losing to eventual premiers, the Wynnum Manly Seagulls 28-36.

The 2019 season will be the last for the Tigers in the A Grade competition; following the decision by the Brisbane based Intrust Super Cup clubs not to field teams in the local A grade competition. The new RLB A Grade competition will see a new 9-team competition, consisting entirely from local Brisbane clubs.

This reform is aimed to increase the opportunity for players to play A Grade rugby league in Brisbane. As a result the Club has entered into affiliation agreements with the Bulimba Bulldogs and the Carina Tigers, which will see the Club allocating our contracted ISC players to Bulimba and Carina when not selected to play Intrust Super Cup.

Thank-you to coach Jason Di Lizio, his support staff and the players for their efforts throughout the season.

HASTINGS DEERING COLTS U20s

Our 2019 Hastings Deering Colts progressed through to the play-offs, winning 9 games of our 20 fixture games. Unfortunately we were beaten 40-20 by the Norths Devils in week 1 of the finals.

AUSBANK MAL MENINGA CUP U18s

Meninga Cup side managed three wins, one draw and two losses from the six competition games in the state-wide U18 competition, which meant we finished in sixth spot on the Auswide Bank Meninga Cup ladder.

SEQ WOMENS SNR DIVISION 1

The Tigers' fielded a women's side for a third season, playing in the South East Queensland's premier women's competition.

Once again we were very competitive, winning 8 from 14 regular fixture games and finished the season in 3rd place. Unfortunately, we were eliminated in the Preliminary Final, going down to the Burleigh Bears 14-6.

PRESIDENT & EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S (CON'T)

JUNIOR ACADEMIES

2019 was a season of growth for our academies with the establishment of the Wide Bay and South West Academies. The Wide Bay Academy based at Bundaberg was established following the QRL's decision for the Bundaberg catchment to be shared between the Tigers and the Central Queensland Capras.

The South West Academy is based at Goondiwindi and was established to provide development opportunities for younger players who are currently not being serviced by an Intrust Super Cup club.

Our academies are a development program for players, aged 13 to 17 years, selected from our junior affiliate clubs and regional areas

The academies have been established to identify and develop talented players in a direct pathway to future representative opportunities with the Tigers. The academies are based on a representative selection model, whereby players are selected by independent selectors.

Academy members are required to attend monthly training sessions whereby players will receive high level of core skill development as well as off-field education

AFFILIATIONS

The Club was pleased to sponsor the Keebra Park State High Rugby league program in 2019. Keebra Park is recognised as one of Australia's leading rugby league schools and has produced a number of NRL stars.

LANGLANDS PARK LEASE

The Club has entered into a 20-year agreement with the Brisbane City Council to lease both Langlands Park and Chadwick Place. The renewal of the Langlands Park lease has taken many years to complete, but this has ensured certainty of tenure for the Club for many years.

In conjunction with the Langlands Park lease renewal, the Club also entered into a 20-year sub-lease/licence agreement with the Eastern Suburbs Leagues Club Ltd (Leagues Club), with a commencing annual rental of \$750,000.

In addition the Club entered into a 5-year sponsorship agreement with the Leagues Club commencing at \$230,000 per annum.

The new sub-lease and sponsorship revenue will be in lieu of the current operating grant model, which have been in place for many years.

On a sad note, the Club Patron Brian Smart passed away in May. Brian will be sadly missed by everyone at the club and our thoughts and prayers go out to his family and friends.


