Dear Members,

INTRUST SUPER CUP (ISC)

The 2020 season was the season that never was.

The Club was looking forward to a strong season with the appointment of former Brisbane Broncos and Gold Coast Titans Assistant Coach Craig Hodges, as the Club's Head Coach for the 2020 and 2021 seasons.

In addition to Craig, we appointed former Brisbane Broncos and Penrith Panthers Athletic Performance Manager Anthony Guilfoyle to the coaching staff, which certainly added to a very professional and experienced team.

The squad had a great pre-season and commenced the season extremely fit and enthusiastic. The side won their Round 1 fixture against the CQ Capras 44-4.

Unfortunately that's where the season ended, with the Queensland Rugby League making the historic decision to cancel all Major Competitions due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

This was the first season the Club had not competed in either the Brisbane Rugby League A Grade or QRL State-League competition since forming in 1933, including the World War II years 1939-1945.

As a result the Club released all players to enable them to register and play local league football. A number of the squad members elected to play for our 'Feeder Clubs', the Carina Tigers and the Bulimba Bulldogs, whilst other decided not to play.

Unfortunately, Craig Hodges resigned from his position to take up an Assistant Coach role with the New Zealand Warriors. This was disappointing as the Club was very excited to see where Craig would take the squad.

We also lost Anthony Guilfoyle who was recruited by the St George Illawarra Dragons.

Following Craig's resignation the Club appointed Terry Matterson to the position of Head Coach for the 2021

and 2022 seasons. Terry coached over 140 games for Castleford Tigers in the UK Superleague and has held Assistant Coach roles with the Canberra Raiders, NQ Cowboys and the Gold Coast Titans.

Again, the Club was unlucky once again, with Terry accepting an assistant coaching role with the Brisbane Broncos and he made his way to Red Hill.

However, the Club was fortunate in we had previously appointed former Souths-Logan Magpies and Wynnum Manly Seagulls coach Jon Buchanan as the Club's Head Pathways Coach. Jon coached the Queensland Residents representative side from 2017-2019.

Jon was offered and accepted the role of Intrust Super Cup Head Coach for the 2021 and 2022 seasons.

HASTINGS DEERING COLTS (U20S)

Like the Intrust Super Cup competition, the Hastings Deering Colts season ended after Round 1 with all Major Competitions being cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

MAL MENINGA CUP (U18S)

Like the Intrust Super Cup competition, the Mal Meninga Cup season ended after Round 1 with all Major Competitions being cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

BHP PREMIERSHIP (WOMENS)

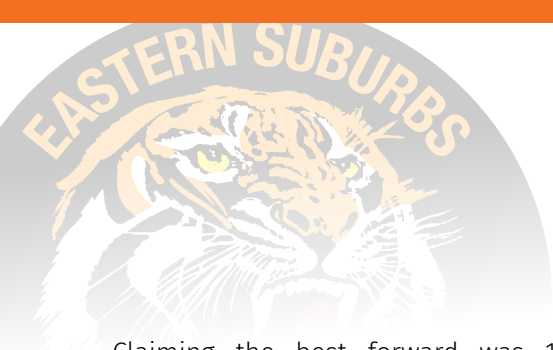
The BHP Premiership was introduced by the QRL in 2020 as Queensland first state-wide open female competition.

Unfortunately our season ended after Round 1 with all Major Competitions being cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

However, the squad re-assembled later in the year to play in a five-round South-East Queensland Holcim Cup competition.

Unfortunately the squad did not progress through to the finals, but being a young side gained a lot of experience playing against older, more experienced sides.

Exciting fullback Keisha-Leigh Coolwell claimed the best back for the Tigers after the 20-year-old registered an impressive season in gold and black.

Claiming the best forward was 19-year-old lock forward Jessikah Reeves who despite her young age had a phenomenal season in the forward pack. Reeves outstanding 2020 campaign saw the exciting youngster rewarded with a Brisbane Broncos NRLW contract.

Head Coach Duane Rehua announced at the presentation that this season would be his last as Head Coach after leading the team for four years. Duane's contribution to the team over the past four seasons cannot be understated.

Duane was responsible for laying the foundation of the women's game at the Club and we thank him for his efforts and wish him the best moving forward.

JUNIOR ACADEMIES

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic the decision was made to cancel the Academies for the 2020 season, however the Academies will re-commence in preparation of the 2021 season.

AFFILIATIONS

The Club was again pleased to sponsor the Keebra Park State High Rugby league program in 2020. Keebra Park is recognised as one of Australia's leading rugby league schools and has produced a number of NRL stars.

The Club affiliated with the Bulimba Bulldogs who played their home games here at Langlands Park during the year.

EXPANSION IN LOGAN CITY

The Club will establish two new junior clubs in the emerging townships of Flagstone and Yarrabilba. Flagstone is expected to have a population of 120,000 people by 2041, whilst Yarrabilba is expected to have a population of 50,000 people.

The junior clubs will be known as Flagstone Tigers and Yarrabilba Tigers and we expect they will commence playing in the younger age groups (U6's to U12's) in 2021.

The establishment of the clubs will provide an opportunity for young boys and girls to play rugby league in these new areas and with it become life-long fans of the game, and particularly the Tigers.

NRL LICENCE BID

Planning is well underway for the Club to submit a bid for the proposed second Brisbane NRL team, should the ARL Commission call for applications in the not too distant future.

The team would be based here at Totally Workwear Stadium, Langlands Park and play the majority of games at Suncorp Stadium.

APPRECIATION

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the Management Committee, players, coaches, support staff and our volunteers who put in such a committed effort to make the Tigers such a great club.

I would also like to thank our partners and sponsors who continually provide financial and in-kind support, which allows the Tigers to compete in Australia's best rugby league competition outside of the NRL.

Special thanks to Easts Leagues Board Chair Mr Stephen Bullow, General Manager Jan Broodryk and the Leagues Club staff for their continued support.

Finally, I would like to thank you, our members and fans for your ongoing support.

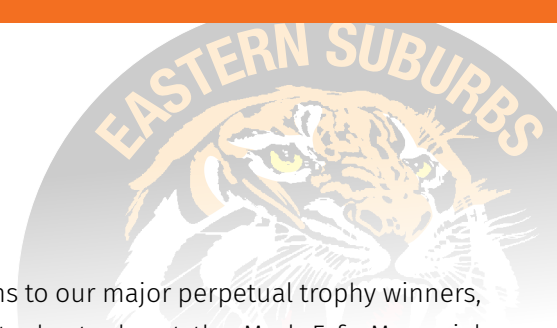

2020 REPORT



2020, what a year?

Our season started with much excitement, preseason training, then COVID. Our season was on, then off, then on again with the Junior Brisbane competition settling on a shortened 10 week season plus finals.

Even with our interrupted and shortened season we still managed to register 375 players from Under 6 to Under 18, including Under 12 and Under 14 all Girls teams. 25 teams from the Junior Division at WJ Scott Park took the rugby league fields all over the greater Brisbane area.

The League Tag program continued in the Under 6 age group after last year's SEQ trial and continued into Under 7 for a number of weeks when they were taught the fundamentals of tackling through the "Tackle Ready" program which was delivered by the NRL Development team.

We had 9 International teams in 2020. The U14 Girls and Under 15 Division 2 Boys both secured Minor Premierships this season as well as bring home the silverware as Premiers as did the Under 15 Division 1 Boys side. The Under 16 Division 1 side made the finals but were unfortunately eliminated. Our Under 18 Nev Blair team played in the Grand Final but were defeated.

Due to COVID there were no Gala Days or Representative duties this season. However at the Mal Meninga and Colts trials held on the 31st of October, 13 of our Juniors (some only 16) made the Mal Meninga squad and 13 Juniors also made the Colts squad.

We hosted 1 weekend of the Junior Finals series this year. I was complemented on the day by a representative for the SEQ Division for how professionally we handled the COVID Safe event. I would like to thank all the volunteers who helped make these days a success.

Presentation Day this year was a little different also as we could not offer the usual rides and activities. It was planned as an outdoor event but at the 11th hour had to move inside due to quite a large thunder storm that swept through. Fortunately we had staggered the presentation times and it went off without a hitch.

Congratulations to our major perpetual trophy winners, Madison Becket who took out the Mark Fyfe Memorial Trophy - Under 18 Player Most Likely to Succeed in Senior Football, and Keith Phillips who was awarded the Len Conroy Memorial Trophy - Club Person of the Year. Andrew Neave was presented with his Life Membership pin. He also won Coach of the Year and was joint winner with Lote Tuqiri as International Team of the Year. Well done to all of the other award winners.
